



Questions A Farmer Should Ask

When Considering Enrollment in Carbon/Ecosystem Programs

1. Can I enroll fields with existing conservation practices? Or do I have to enroll fields with new conservation practices?
2. Do my fields need to be in a specific area to be eligible?
3. Do I have to be a customer/client to participate?
4. Can I enroll in other public or private conservation programs at the same time on the same field?
5. What data do I need to provide to enroll?
6. What are the data sharing and privacy policies?
7. Do I have to own the fields to enroll? Or can I enroll rented fields?
8. Do I pay for monitoring or verification?
9. Is agronomy or conservation technical assistance provided at no cost?
10. Are there acre minimums or maximums?
11. When do I receive payment?
12. Is payment guaranteed for the term of the contract?
13. What ecosystem services are being accounted for in the contract? Am I being paid for other ecosystem services? If so, how much?
14. What is the length of the contract?
15. What are the contract terms? What happens if I am unable to fulfill the terms of the contract?
